Ethnic Group *In the light of our Mission Statement, we ask what may be viewed as a very sensitive question: namely “ethnic origin”. One reason is to facilitate our use of your special gifts in certain ministries. Those who are Hispanic might help us to be more effective in our Social Justice Outreach Ministry office; those who are African American would be especially attuned to our ministries which celebrates our proud beginnings and our outreach to our immediate neighborhood. Another very useful reason is to facilitate grant writing proposals which require parish demographics.*

Collection Envelopes *are now issued at the time of registration due to the 2007 Internal Revenue Service change in tax reporting requirements. That said, at OLQP collection envelopes are issued for tracking contributions only (not a policy whereby usage is mandatory to prove membership).
