FR. TIM'S JUST A THOUGHT...OR TWO...

Happy birthday to the Church, to this parish community of Our Lady Queen of Peace and to the Spiritan Community. We are thankful for the Holy Spirit's coming upon Mary and the other disciples on that amazing and shocking Pentecost so many centuries ago. An event that unleashed a religious revolution that has, down through the centuries, in one way or another impacted the whole world.

We are thankful for our courageous Black Catholic sisters and brothers who, filled with the Holy Spirit, went to Richmond to meet with the bishop and ask for a parish of their own where they could worship in dignity and be treated with love and respect. And we are thankful for the Spiritan Congregation who responded to the call from the Bishop of Richmond to come to Arlington and work with the first Black Catholic Families to start a new Black Catholic parish community. We are thankful to all my brother Spiritans who have shepherded this parish community for 79 years. We offer a prayer of gratitude for all the parishioners and clergy who have gone before us, filled with the Holy Spirit and labored to create this wonderful parish community. And we are grateful for all of you today who make up this amazing parish community. Thank you for all you do to make OLQP what it is today! Happy 79th anniversary to Our Lady Queen of Peace Parish Community!

St. Augustine said that the Spirit blows where the Spirit wills...not exactly comforting if you are someone who likes things neat and orderly or if you prefer to have life all figured out and neatly packaged. Most of us would prefer to see life's decisions as right or wrong, good or bad...as if everything in life were black and white. The problem with life is that most of the time we are living in the grey; everything is not black and white! This is where the Holy Spirit offers counsel -- the challenge is to be open to the Spirit's counsel! The Holy Spirit blows where it wills and inspires and guides whomever it chooses, whenever and wherever it chooses.

Most of us get use to a particular routine and we find comfort in doing things in particular ways and we find discomfort when our routine gets changed by outside influences or when we are forced to do things in a different or new way. It is no different in the church. We all get comfortable in the way we worship, in the way we pray, in the way we sing, in what we sing, and then when change comes we suddenly are set off center and we feel "off balance" at the change or new ways.

This reality has probably never been clearer or truer than during these past few years of the COVID pandemic. First the closing of masses to the public and then reopening but with restrictions on how many could come to church and how we could reassemble! All this without any certainty on when we would be able to return to something that looked like it used to look and feel.

But we did return as it got safer for everyone, and we once more began to raise our voices in full song, most without masks, and we can once again greet our sisters and brothers with a sign of the peace of Christ! And we can all come forward to the Table of the Lord!

I am sure that many in the church today see the Pope's challenge to live a radically gospel centered life as a change from what they were used to -- a change in what they thought it meant to be a Catholic and it throws them off balance.

In answering the Gospel's call, Pope Francis has called us out of the church building and into the streets to be a "field hospital" where binding up the wounds of the poor and brokenhearted is a priority.

The Pope is following the radical call of Christ, who calls us to be a welcoming presence to immigrants and refugees, to seek out the lost and forsaken and to "be" the word of peace in the presence of war, to "be" the word of love spoken to the lonely and marginalized of the world, to "be" the word of justice and equality spoken in the midst of racial injustice and exclusion.

As well, we are called to be care takers of creation, to take responsibility for the way we live on the planet: personally, communally, nationally and internationally.

While all of this can seem overwhelming, we need to remember that we are not called to do all this by ourselves but rather as a community filled with, and guided by, the Holy Spirit. It is in and through the powerful presence of the Holy Spirit within us and around us that we are able to do all good things!

As we celebrate the great feast of Pentecost let each of us ask ourselves *to where* and *to what* is the Holy Spirit calling me in my life?

Happy 79th anniversary Our Lady Queen of Peace! Amen.

NEWS FROM MEDOR

Currently 200 students from Medor's primary and secondary school are enrolled in an Environmental Education Program. The Program is run by the Smallholder Farmers Alliance, the group that implements St. Joseph parish's Agro-forestry Program. The Environmental Education Program includes didactic lessons on caring for our common home, as well as hands-on experience, working in the school's tree nursery, planting and caring for trees, and growing organic beans in the school's garden. Students are encouraged to share their knowledge with their parents and others, increasing the impact. El domingo de Pentecostés, conocido a través del mundo como “el cumpleaños de la Iglesia”, ¡es también “el cumpleaños” de nuestra comunidad parroquial!

Y entonces no es coincidencia que el domingo de Pentecostés, 20 de mayo de 1945, ¡hace 79 AÑOS ESTE FIN DE SEMANA! – el Padre Joe Hackett, CSSp., el primer párroco de Nuestra Señora Reina de la Paz y un grupo de devotos y determinados católicos negros — **Joseph Bowman , Clarence and Selena Brown, Alice Butler, Lawrence and Jessie Butler, Irma Carter, Hattie Ellis, Mary Fernanders, Edward Marshall, Grace Mcgwin, Edward and Alice Moorman, Constance Spencer Lautier, Sophia Terry, Thaddenia West** — celebraron la primera misa de la parroquia en la casa de Lawrence y Jessie Butler. Los Espiritanos (la Congregación del Espíritu Santo) también se fundó el domingo de Pentecostés en 1703 en París, Francia.

Los Espiritanos tienen una rica historia de servir a los pobres y marginados. A principios de la década del 1732, viajaron a América del Norte para trabajar con los indios Micmac que vivían en lo que luego se convertiría en el noreste de los Estados Unidos. A partir de la década del 1840 en las islas de Haití, Mauricio y Reunión, y más tarde en los Estados Unidos, los Espiritanos se dedicaron a trabajar con esclavos recién liberados y poblaciones inmigrantes. En África del Este empezaron a trabajar en la década del 1860 rescatando a hombres, mujeres y niños que habían sido esclavizados en Zanzíbar. Abrieron escuelas y hospitales, enseñaron habilidades comerciales a personas y les dieron propiedades a quienes las necesitaban.

A los Espiritanos se les acredita la actividad misionera pionera de la época moderna en África y, a la larga, enviaron más misioneros allí que cualquier otra institución religiosa en la Iglesia católica. En muchos países, los obispos católicos locales invitaron a los Espiritanos a pastorear a los católicos en áreas remotas donde tenían dificultades en obtener a otros sacerdotes que pastorearan. Hoy en día los Espiritanos figuran cerca de 3,000 sacerdotes, hermanos y laicos asociados y trabajan en unos más de 60 países del mundo.

Al celebrar el domingo de Pentecostés y el 79 aniversario de nuestra parroquia como parroquia Espiritana, también celebramos el 321 aniversario de los Espiritanos!

PENTECOST SUNDAY,
known around the world as
"the birthday of the church"
is also "the birthday" of our
parish community!

And, so it was no coincidence on Pentecost Sunday May 20, 1945—79 YEARS AGO THIS WEEKEND! — Father Joe Hackett, CSSp, the first pastor of Our Lady Queen of Peace, and a group of devoted and determined Black Catholics — **Joseph Bowman , Clarence and Selena Brown, Alice Butler, Lawrence and Jessie Butler, Irma Carter, Hattie Ellis, Mary Fernanders, Edward Marshall, Grace Mcgwin, Edward and Alice Moorman, Constance Spencer Lautier, Sophia Terry, Thaddenia West** — celebrated the first Mass of the parish in the home of Lawrence and Jessie Butler. The Spiritans (the Congregation of the Holy Spirit) were also founded on Pentecost Sunday (1703 in Paris, France).

The Spiritans have a rich history of serving the poor and marginalized. In 1732 they journeyed to North America to work with the Micmac Indians and Acadians in French Canada . Beginning in the 1840s on the islands of Haiti, Mauritius and Reunion and later in the United States, the Spiritans dedicated themselves to working with newly freed slaves and immigrant populations. In East Africa they began work in the 1860s by rescuing men, women and children out of slavery in Zanzibar. They opened schools and hospitals, taught people marketable skills, and gave property to those who needed it.

The Spiritans are credited with pioneering modern missionary activity in Africa and ultimately sent more missionaries there than any other religious institute in the Catholic Church. In many countries the Spiritans were invited by the local Catholic bishops to minister to Catholics in remote areas where they had difficulty getting other priests to minister. Today the Spiritans number about 3000 priests, brothers and lay associates and work in over 60 countries around the globe.

As we celebrate Pentecost Sunday and our parish's 79th anniversary, as a Spiritan parish we also celebrate the Spiritans' 321st
